The meeting was attended by the Foreign Ministers of the G7 countries and the High Representative of the EU. Mr. Fumio Kishida, Minister for Foreign Affairs, attended from Japan. After the meeting, the G7 Foreign Ministers' Meeting Communiqué, the G7 Foreign Ministers' Declaration on Maritime Security, "Beyond Ebola: a G7 agenda to help prevent future crises and enhance security in Africa" and the G7 Statement on Non-Proliferation and Disarmament, respectively, were released.
