1. Notes on ELIGIBILITY

- ♦ Applicants must be U.S. citizens living in Washington, Montana, Idaho, Oregon, and Alaska. Please contact the nearest Japanese Embassy/Consulate in your area if you do not reside in our jurisdiction.
- ♦ If you possess and maintain *dual citizenship with Japan and the U.S.* you are *not eligible to apply* for the Japanese Government Scholarship *unless* you renounce your Japanese citizenship.
- ◆ Those who will be graduating from high school by March 2018 are eligible to apply.

2. Notes on the APPLICATION FORM

- ◆ *Please submit all documents at once* including the transcripts and recommendation letters. We do not wish to have these documents sent directly from the respective offices.
- ◆ Please be sure that your documents are numbered as instructed in the Guidelines.

3. Notes on PRELIMINARY SELECTION

Qualified candidates will be contacted and asked to visit the Consulate General of Japan in Seattle for an examination and interview.
