Salary Assistance Grant

for Japanese-Language Courses

Grant Result: Late May

This program supports educational institutions or school districts in the U.S. that are facing temporary financial difficulties in the following three cases:

Case (1) Starting up a brand new Japanese program

Case (2) **Expanding** a current existing program by adding new course(s)/section(s)

Case (3) Maintaining a current program which is in danger of cut back or closure

The grant covers a part of the Japanese language instructor's **salary** and **fringe benefits** <u>up to \$30,000 per year</u> <u>on a cost-sharing basis</u>. The grant support is up to **two years for Case (1)**, and **one year for Case (2)** and **(3)**.

It is required that applying instructions submit <u>commitment letter(s)</u> or <u>support letter(s)</u> from <u>stakeholders</u> (e.g., Dean, Dept. Chair, District Superintendent, Head of Board of Education, Principal, or local supporters, etc.) at the time of application <u>regarding the continuation of their Japanese program beyond the grant period</u>.

Two deadlines:

March 15 & September 15

Grant Result: April and October



Japanese Teaching

Material Purchase Grant

This program assists educational institutions in the U.S. with purchasing teaching materials for their Japanese-language courses by providing financial support <u>up to \$1,000</u>.

Items eligible for support include textbooks, audio-visual materials, digital learning software, dictionaries, teacher's reference books, cultural items (calligraphy sets, origami, yukata, etc.)

The grant will NOT cover electronic devices (such as laptop computers, tablets, digital cameras, projectors, etc.) and consumable stationery supplies (papers, pens, etc.).

Two deadlines: March 1st & September 1st

Japanese Language **Learners Event Grant**

Grant Results: April and October

This program provides financial assistance up to \$1,000 for national/statewide/regional-level events for learners of Japanese language such as statewide speech contests, statewide quiz contests, presentational events, etc. that are intended to motivate learners and promote Japanese-language education in a wide region.

Eligible items for support are:

- 1) Expenses for Judges/Guest Speakers (honorarium, travel expense),
- 2) Expenses for **Venue** (venue rental, audio equipment rental, etc.),
- 3) Expenses for **Prizes** (prizes for Japanese-language learners), and
- 4) Production costs for **Programs/Handouts/Flyers**.
- 5) Group transportation costs for participants/student audiences (charter buses, vans, etc.)



Washington Statewide Speech and Skit Contest

Year-round deadline: Two months prior to the project start date

Japanese Language Education Project Grant

Grant Result: Within one month after receiving application

This program provides financial assistance up to \$5,000 for nationwide or statewide/regional-level projects that are implemented by non-profit educational institutions/organizations to promote Japanese-language education in a wide region.

Project Examples:

- Workshops, conferences, seminars for Japanese language teachers
- Original projects (e.g., advocacy projects, teaching material development, survey/research projects, etc.)

Items eligible for support will vary depending on the type of projects.

Possible items for support include "Expenses for keynote speakers/lecturers (honorarium, travel costs)," "Venue and equipment rental fees," and "Printing costs for programs, handouts, flyers," etc.
