

Update on Recovery at the Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Station

The Government of Japan has updated its comprehensive report on recovery operations at the Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Station (NPS). This report has been available on the International Atomic Energy Agency's (IAEA) website since February 27, together with the IAEA's own assessment for the purpose of sharing information with the international community.

Highlights from IAEA's Latest Assessment of the February report:

- The marine environment is stable and tests by the IAEA have shown a high level of accuracy in the data reported by Japanese laboratories on seawater sampling.
- The IAEA considers measures taken to monitor and respond to issues regarding radionuclide contamination of food appropriate, and the food supply chain under control.
