1. Notes on ELIGIBILITY

- ◆ Applicants must be U.S. citizens living in Washington, Montana, Idaho, Oregon, and Alaska. Please contact the nearest Japanese Embassy/Consulate in your area if you do not reside in our jurisdiction.
- ◆ If you possess and maintain *dual citizenship with Japan and the U.S.* you are *not eligible to apply* for the Japanese Government Scholarship *unless* you renounce your Japanese citizenship.
- ◆ You must be currently enrolled in a *4-year university* as an undergraduate student and must be *majoring in Japan-related studies*.
- ◆ You must be born between April 2, 1985 and April 1, 1997.
- ◆ You must have at least one year of Japanese language education by April 2015.

- **♦** Health Form is only required from those who pass the Preliminary Selection at our office.
- ◆ **Please submit all documents at once** including the transcripts and recommendation letters. We do not wish to have these documents sent directly from the respective offices.
