### 1. Notes on ELIGIBILITY

- ♦ Applicants must be U.S. citizens living in Washington, Montana, Idaho, Oregon, and Alaska. Please contact the nearest Japanese Embassy/Consulate in your area if you do not reside in our jurisdiction.
- ♦ If you possess and maintain *dual citizenship with Japan and the U.S.* you are *not eligible to apply* for the Japanese Government Scholarship *unless* you renounce your Japanese citizenship.
- ◆ Those who will be graduating from high school by March 2016 are eligible to apply.

#### 2. Notes on the APPLICATION FORM

- ◆ *Please submit all documents at once* including the transcripts and recommendation letters. We do not wish to have these documents sent directly from the respective offices.
- ♦ Health Form is only required from those who pass the Preliminary Selection at our office.

### 3. Notes on PRELIMINARY SELECTION

Qualified candidates will be contacted and asked to visit the Consulate General of Japan in Seattle for an examination and interview.
