### **1. Notes on ELIGIBILITY**

◆ *Applicants must be U.S. citizens living in Washington, Montana, Idaho, Oregon, and Alaska.* Please contact the nearest Japanese Embassy/Consulate in your area if you do not reside in our jurisdiction.

◆ If you possess and maintain *dual citizenship with Japan and the U.S.* you are *not eligible to apply* for the Japanese Government Scholarship *unless* you renounce your Japanese citizenship.

◆ *Those who will be graduating from high school by March 2018* are eligible to apply.

### **2. Notes on the APPLICATION FORM**

◆ *Please submit all documents at once* including the transcripts and recommendation letters. We do not wish to have these documents sent directly from the respective offices.

◆ *Please be sure that your documents are numbered* as instructed in the Guidelines.

### **3. Notes on PRELIMINARY SELECTION**

Qualified candidates will be contacted and asked to visit the Consulate General of Japan in Seattle for an examination and interview.

**Interview and Exam Date: Week of June 12-16, 2017.**
