- 3. Download and complete the Application Form.

- 5. Have your doctor complete the Certificate of Health.
- 6. Collect other supplemental documents (see Application Guidelines, pages 6-8).

- 8. Mail all of your application materials in one packet to the address above. Applications must be <u>received</u> by February 20 in order to be considered.

### **Eligibility:**

- Applicants must be U.S. citizens living in Washington State, Montana, Idaho, Oregon, or Alaska. Please contact the nearest Japanese Embassy/Consulate in your area if you do not reside in our jurisdiction.
- If you possess and maintain dual citizenship with Japan and the U.S. you are not eligible to apply for the Japanese Government Scholarship unless you renounce your Japanese citizenship.
- You must be currently enrolled in a 4-year university as an undergraduate student and must be majoring in Japan-related studies.
- Your date of birth must be between April 2, 1989, and April 1, 2001.
- You must have at least one year of Japanese language education by September 2019.

### **Preliminary Selection:**

Qualified candidates will be contacted and asked to visit the Consulate-General of Japan in Seattle for an examination and interview in early March 2019 (exact date TBA).
