Application Instructions:

- 1. Follow the link to the Study in Japan website.
- 2. Carefully read the Application Guidelines for the scholarship you wish to apply for.
- 3. Download and complete the Application Form and all additional documents.
- 4. Collect all supplemental documents (see Application Guidelines, pages 5-7).
- 5. Number each document and make the necessary number of copies, as instructed in the Application Guidelines.
- 6. Mail all of your application materials in *one packet* to the address above.

Eligibility:

- Applicants must be U.S. citizens living in Washington, Montana, Idaho, Oregon, or Alaska. Please contact the nearest Japanese Embassy/Consulate in your area if you do not reside in our jurisdiction.
- If you possess and maintain dual citizenship with Japan and the U.S. you are not eligible to apply for the Japanese Government Scholarship unless you renounce your Japanese citizenship.
- You must meet the other requirements of age, academic background, etc. as stipulated in the Application Guidelines.

Preliminary Selection:

Qualified candidates will be contacted and asked to visit the Consulate-General of Japan in Seattle for an exam and interview. Exams and interviews are tentatively scheduled for June 13-14, but these dates are subject to change.
