1. <u>Japan-UK Foreign Ministers' Telephone Talk</u>

On September 9, Foreign Minister Motegi and Rt Hon Dominic Raab MP, Secretary of State for Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Affairs and First Secretary of State of the United Kingdom, held a telephone talk. Both sides affirmed that they will promote further cooperation in the areas of security and defense towards the realization of a "Free and Open Indo-Pacific." The two ministers also exchanged views on the situation in Afghanistan and affirmed that they will coordinate closely in responding to the situation.

<u>Treated Water at TEPCO's Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Station (FDNPS)</u> In this session on September 10, Ministries of Foreign Affairs, Economy, Trade and Industry (Agency for Natural Resources and Energy), as well as the Nuclear Regulation Authority gave an overview of IAEA Deputy General Ms. Lydie Evrard's visit to Japan, followed by a Q&A session. The Government of Japan continues to explain the situation of the handling of ALPS treated water at the FDNPS to the international community in a transparent manner.

3. Agreement between Japan and Vietnam concerning the Transfer of Defense

General Mr. Hoang Xuan Chien, Deputy Minister of National Defence of Vietnam, signed an agreement that establishes a legal framework regarding the transfer and handling of defense equipment and technology. It will allow the two governments to implement joint projects, including those contributing to international peace and stability. The conclusion of this agreement will ensure appropriate control over the defense equipment and technology transferred between Japan and Vietnam, especially regarding any subsequent transfer to a third party or any extra-purpose use.

4. <u>Joint Communication on the EU Strategy for Cooperation in the Indo-Pacific</u> On September 16, the European Union (EU) announced the Joint Communication on

the EU Strategy for Cooperation in the Indo-Pacific. In a statement, Foreign Minister Motegi said the Government of Japan welcomes the EU's announcement of their specific measures, together with their strong will, for their engagement in the Indo-Pacific. The announcement resonates with Japan's views and efforts for a "Free and Open Indo-Pacific (FOIP)." Japan and the EU will continue to further advance concrete cooperation with a view to realizing FOIP.
