On October 27, Prime Minister Kishida attended the 24th ASEAN-Japan Summit, the ASEAN Plus Three (Japan-China-Republic of Korea) Summit, and the East Asia Summit meetings.

During the meetings, the Prime Minister discussed Japan's support for countermeasures

against the COVID-19 pandemic, including increasing access to vaccines, as well as cooperation on trade, and both regional and international issues. Kishida stated his intention to continue to work closely with the participating countries to ensure that the Indo-Pacific region will remain a free, open, peaceful, and prosperous region.


