## **TRANSIT**

**[Definition]** A foreign citizen traveling stand-by OR who must leave the airport while enroute to a third country, such as passengers with overnight flight connections or passengers arriving in Japan at one airport and departing from a different airport (for example, Narita to Haneda or vice versa). For passengers who transit in Japan for immediate flight connections and are not required to go through immigration clearance, a visa is not required.

[Validity of Visa] Single entry: 3 months from date of issue Double entry: 4 months from date of issue
<b>REQUIREMENTS:</b> □ <b>VALID PASSPORT:</b> Properly signed by bearer, must have at least one blank VISA page
□ PROOF OF YOUR U.S. IMMIGRATION STATUS: □ Copy of Valid U.S. Permanent Resident Card (Green card) □ Copy of Valid U.S. Visa (if necessary, AND copy of I-797) (If you have a Valid F1 Visa, AND I-20 with valid travel endorsement signature, (if applicable, EAD card)) (If you have a Valid J1 Visa, AND DS-2019 with valid travel endorsement signature)
□ <b>COMPLETED VISA APPLICATION FORM:</b> ( <u>Visa Application Form</u> ): The applicant must complete the visa application form in black pen or typed. Signature must be original. On the application form, if there is a field not applicable, please write "N/A" or "None". <u>Please reference this sample form when filling out the application</u> .
□ ONE PASSPORT SIZE PHOTOGRAPH: 2X1.4 inch photograph must be taken within the last six months with plain background
□ FLIGHT ITINERARY/RESERVATION:  Must have the visa applicant's name and date along with the flight information (starting with the US AND including the flight to/from Japan). You do not need to purchase your airline ticket until the visa is approved, however, you need to make a reservation. You may want to consider adding trip protection or insurance should you need to cancel. In order to make a reservation without purchase, please consult with the airline or travel agency * Please Note: We are not responsible for tickets, which are unusable due to delay or denial of visa.
