

Regarding Changes to Visa Fees

Visa fees will change effective July 1, 2026 (Wednesday).

The new fees are as follows:

Single-entry visa: \$101 (remains \$6 for Indian nationals)

Multiple-entry visa: \$201 (remains \$6 for Indian nationals)

Transit visa: Discontinued (currently valid transit visas remain usable)

- The current fees apply only to visa applications that arrive or are deposited by June 30 and for which all required documents are complete.
- Visa applications are accepted only when all necessary documents are complete. Therefore, the fee applicable at the time the application is accepted (i.e., when all additional documents are provided) will apply.
- If documents were submitted before June 30 but the Visa Section requested additional documents, and the application was accepted (with the additional documents provided) by June 30, the current fee applies.
- If documents were submitted before June 30 but the Visa Section requested additional documents, and the application was accepted (with the additional documents provided) on or after July 1, the new fee applies, and the difference must be paid.

Example 1

Documents were mailed on June 25, but they arrived at the Consulate after 4:30 PM on June 30; the arrival date is considered July 1.

(= The new fee applies; the difference in fees must be paid.)

Example 2

Documents were deposited in the drop box on June 25, but the Visa Section requested a new photo because the submitted one was older than six months. If the new photo is submitted on July 1, the application acceptance date is considered July 1. (= As the new fee structure applies, the difference in fees must be paid.)

Example 3

Visa application documents arrived at the consulate on June 25, but because certain items (flight e-ticket, hotel reservation confirmation, itinerary, visa fee payment slip, multiple-entry visa request form, ROL, return envelope, etc.) were omitted, the visa section requested the submission of the missing documents.

If the missing documents are submitted on or after July 1, the new fee structure applies, and the difference in fees must be paid.

Example 4

Notification was received regarding incomplete information on the visa application form (e.g., missing signature, unanswered questions).

If the corrected application documents are submitted on July 1, the official acceptance date for the visa application becomes July 1.

(= As the new fee structure applies, the difference in fees must be paid.)
